AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF AN ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES  
LICENSE IN THE CITY OF MARLBOROUGH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 17 of  
2 chapter one hundred thirty-eight of the General Laws, the  
3 Licensing authority of the City of Marlborough is hereby autho-  
4 rized to issue an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic  
5 beverages to be drunk on the premises under the provisions of  
6 section 12 of said chapter one hundred thirty-eight to the Marl-  
7 borough Masonic Corporation, 208 Main Street, Marlborough.  
8 Said license shall be subject to all of the provisions of said  
9 chapter one hundred thirty-eight except said section seventeen;  
10 provided, however, that the licensing authority shall not approve  
11 the transfer of said license to any other location.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon passage.
