2 sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation
3 and study of current Senate document 1288 relative to cost-of-
4 living adjustments for public retirees.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of
6 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
8 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
9 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
10 December, 2000.
