AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TIMBER BULKHEAD IN OAK BLUFFS HARBOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, the town of Oak Bluffs is hereby
3 authorized to administer the use of the timber bulkhead in Oak
4 Bluffs harbor, constructed pursuant to the provisions of chapter
5 twenty-nine of the resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty-one,
6 and may make such rules, regulations and charges for their use as
7 may seem reasonable; provided, however, that the board of
8 selectmen shall have the authority to enter into lease agreements
9 of the structure and land abutting thereon and approaches thereto
10 for terms up to and including five years; provided, further that
11 any lease term exceeding five years shall require the prior
12 approval of the town meeting.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter four hundred seventy-four of the Acts of
2 nineteen fifty-two is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
