AN ACT EXEMPTING A CERTAIN POSITION IN THE TOWN OF BILLERICA FROM  
THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The position of water meter reader in the town of  
2 Billerica shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter 31 of the  
3 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
