1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Health Care be authorized to
2 sit during the recess of the General Court to make an investigation
3 and study of current house documents numbered 2122, relative to
4 an investigation by a special commission on the distribution to
5 hospitals of uncompensated care funds; and 3473, relative to the
6 uncompensated care pool for certain hospitals.

7 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of
8 its investigation and its recommendations, if any, together with
9 drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into
10 effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Represen-
11 tatives on or before the last Wednesday in December, nineteen
12 hundred and ninety-nine.
