The committee on Public Safety, to whom were referred the message from His Honor His Excellency the Governor recommending legislation relative to reducing drug and alcohol crimes committed by juveniles (House, No. 4183), the message from His Excellency the Governor recommending legislation relative to establishing certain attendance requirements for minors to obtain a driver's license (House, No. 4189), the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1230) of Thomas P. Kennedy for legislation to require the use of seat belts in taxicabs, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3739) of Harriette L. Chandler relative to the registration of certain motor vehicles, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4310) of Anthony J. Verga for legislation to authorize the city of Gloucester to regulate motor vehicle speed limits on all streets and roadways within said city, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4417) of Cele Hahn and Michael R. Knapik (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to authorize the city of Westfield to regulate motor vehicle speed limits on all streets and roadways within said city, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 4643) ought to be adopted.

3 and study of House documents numbered 1230, 3739, 4183, 4189,
4 4310 and 4417 relative to motor vehicle safety and other related

7 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
8 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
9 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
10 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
11 December, nineteen hundred and ninety-nine.
