2 to sit during the recess of the General Court to make an investiga-
3 tion and study of House document numbered 3430 relative to the
4 crime of murder.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of
6 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
8 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the
9 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
10 December, 2000.
