

By Mr. Vallee of Franklin, petition of James E. Vallee (by vote of the town) relative to exempting certain positions in the school department of the city known as the town of Franklin from the provisions of civil service law. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The positions of junior custodian, senior custo-
2 dian and grounds maintenance person in the school department in
3 the town of Franklin shall be exempt from the provisions of
4 chapter 31 of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section one shall not impair the
2 civil service status of any incumbent holding permanent civil
3 service status in the positions of junior custodian, senior custodian
4 and grounds maintenance person in the school department in the
5 town of Franklin on the effective date of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
