

By Mrs. Murray of Cohasset, petition of Mary Jeanette Murray and Robert L. Hedlund (by vote of the town) that the town of Hingham be authorized to lease a certain parcel of park land located in said town. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF HINGHAM TO LEASE CERTAIN PARK LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Hingham acting by and through its
2 board of selectmen is hereby authorized to lease, for a term of 99
3 years, a certain parcel of land located in said town which was
4 acquired for park and open space purposes to be used for business
5 purposes. Said parcel is bound and described as follows:

- 6 Commencing at a stone bound on the northerly side of Lincoln
- 7 Street and running along the boundary between parcel 102 and 103
- 8 N20°07'55"E for a distance of 10.65 feet to the point beginning;
- 9 Thence, S62°32'55"E 79.65 feet over parcel 103 to a point;
- 10 Thence, N20°07'55"E 127.25 feet over parcel 103 to a point;
- 11 Thence, N69°52'05"W 79.00 feet over parcel 103 to the point
- 12 of beginning.
- 13 S20°07'55"W, 117.10 feet along the boundary between parcels
- 14 102 and 103 to the point of beginning.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
