AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NEWTON TO FIX REASONABLE FEES FOR CERTAIN TAX DISCHARGES AND INSTRUMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, the city of Newton, by ordinance, may
3 fix reasonable fees for all discharges, releases, disclaimers, instru-
4 ments acknowledging payment or satisfaction and certificates,
5 including but not limited to certificates of taxes and assessments
6 pursuant to chapter 60, section 23, issued by the office of the col-
7 lector-treasurer.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon passage.
