
By Mr. Galvin of Canton, petition of William C. Galvin and Brian A. Joyce (by vote of the town) relative to abolishing the position of clerk/treasurer and creating the positions of clerk/registrar and treasurer/collector in the town of Randolph. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT ABOLISHING THE POSITION OF CLERK/TREASURER AND CREATING THE NEW POSITIONS OF CLERK/REGISTRAR AND TREASURER/COLLECTOR IN THE TOWN OF RANDOLPH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter ninety-two of the Acts and Resolves of
2 nineteen hundred and eighty-two is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. The office of Town Clerk for the town of Ran-
2 dolph is hereby separated from the office of treasurer, and the
3 Town Clerk shall continue to be an ex officio member of the
4 Board of Registrars in accordance with the general laws. The
5 office of the Clerk/Registrar shall be an elected office whose
6 holder shall be chosen by ballot from said town's registered voters
7 for a term of three years and whose first holder shall be that
8 person presently holding the office of Clerk/Treasurer. Thereafter,
9 the Clerk/Registrar shall be elected next at the first regularly
10 scheduled town election following completion of the term of
11 office of the present Clerk/Treasurer in April 2003, said term
12 of office to commence seven days following election in accor-
13 dance with chapter 41, section 107 of the general laws. The provi-
14 sions of law relative to clerk and registrar, except insofar as the
15 same may be inconsistent with the provisions of this act, shall
16 apply to the office of Clerk/Registrar.

1 SECTION 3. The office of treasurer for the Town of Randolph
2 is hereby separated from the office of the Clerk/Treasurer and the
3 office of Treasurer is hereby merged with the office of Collector
4 for the Town of Randolph into one office of Treasurer/Collector.
5 All the powers and duties of the Treasurer and of the Collector
6 shall be exercised by the Treasurer/Collector. The office of Treas-
7 surer/Collector shall be an elected position whose holder shall be
8 chosen by ballot from said Town's registered voters for the term
9 of three years and whose first holder shall be that person holding
10 the office of Town Collector at the time of the effective date of
11 this act. Thereafter, the Treasurer/Collector shall be elected next at
12 the regularly scheduled town election following completion of the
13 term of office of the present Town Collector in April 2002. The
14 provision of law relative to Treasurer and Collector, except insofar
15 as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions of this act,
16 shall apply to the office of Treasurer/Collector.

1 SECTION 4. The term of office of the person holding the com-
2 bined office of Treasurer/Clerk, under the former Chapter 92 of
3 the Acts and Resolves of 1982 shall cease and terminate upon
4 qualification of a Treasurer/Collector to the new position created
5 by the act.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon passage.
