AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WALPOLE TO ISSUE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF WINES AND MALT BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 17 of chapter 138 of  
2 the General Laws, the licensing authority of the town of Walpole  
3 may issue to North Country Cuisine a license for the sale of wines  
4 and malt beverages not to be drunk on the premises under the pro-  
5 visions of section 15 of said chapter 138. Said license shall be  
6 subject to all the provisions of said chapter 138, except said  
7 section 17.
