## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS  
POLICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Group 2 of paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of sec-  
2 tion 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1994  
3 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 269,  
4 the words “; University of Massachusetts police”.

1 SECTION 2. Group 4 of said paragraph (g) of said subdivi-  
2 sion (2) of said section 3 of said chapter 32, as most recently  
3 amended by section 52 of chapter 38 of the acts of 1995, is hereby  
4 further amended by inserting after the words “correctional facili-  
5 ties” the following words:— ; police officers of the University of  
6 Massachusetts.
