AN ACT RELATIVE TO SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES' COMPENSA-  
TION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby established a special commission  
2 to study and compare the salaries of Sheriff Department employees  
3 relative to one another and to state employees with similar titles.  
4 Said commission will issue a report along with recommendations  
5 no later than December 1, 2001.

1 SECTION 2. The special commission will consist of the Senate  
2 and House Chairmen of the Committee on Public Service, who  
3 will be co-Chairs of said commission, the Senate and House  
4 Chairmen of the Committee on Counties, the Personnel Adminis-  
5 trator of the Commonwealth, a representative of the National  
6 Association of Government Employees, a representative of  
7 Local 254 SEIU, a representative of AFSCME, and one member  
8 of the minority Party of the House of Representatives and the  
9 State Senate appointed by the minority leadership.

1 SECTION 3. The office of the Personnel Administrator shall  
2 provide whatever technical and administrative support that the  
3 special commission requires.
