AN ACT TO REGULATE CONTRACTS FOR EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section forty-one of Chapter 71, as appearing in the 1998 Official
2 Edition of the General Laws, is amended in paragraph three by
3 striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentences:— A principal, assistant principal, department
5 head or other supervisor who has served in that position for three
6 consecutive years, and who has not been notified of non-renewal
7 sixty days prior to the end of the third consecutive year, shall not be
8 dismissed or demoted except for good cause. Good cause shall
9 include a description of the personal misconduct or professional
10 deficiency or deficiencies which are the basis for the dismissal. The
11 declaration by the proper authorities that the principal's school is an
12 underperforming school shall satisfy this provision.
