AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TOLLS AT THE SUMNER AND TED WILLIAMS TUNNELS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special laws to the contrary, the
- 2 Board of Directors of the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority are
- 3 hereby authorized and directed to limit the tolls charged to
- 4 Winthrop and Revere residents at the Sumner and Ted Williams
- 5 Tunnels to one dollar.

to the House of Representatives of the United States and
to the Senate of the United States for their consideration
and approval or disapproval of the same and for their
transmission to the President of the United States.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

ARTICLE I

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested
in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a
Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of
Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several
States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications
 requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State
 Legislature.

1. No Representative shall be chosen until he has attained to
21 Years of Age, seven Years of Residence in that State, and
7 Years of Citizenship in the United States; and when elected he
shall, before he enters on his Office, be qualified in every
other Respect as Electors in that State are qualified.
2. The House of Representatives shall elect their Speaker and
other Officers; and shall have the sole Power of Impeachment.
