### AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXPENSES INCURRED IN DEFENSE AGAINST UNFAIR LABOR PRACTICES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 15 of Chapter 150E of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1990 Official Edition, is amended by adding a new para-
- 3 graph after line 22 as follows:—
- 4 Any labor organization who has incurred expense in success-
- 5 fully challenging an unfair labor practice or any other violation of
- 6 this chapter, and who has engaged an attorney for such challenge
- 7 shall be reimbursed for such reasonable expenses.
