AN ACT TO ACCOMMODATE THE PATRIOTIC EXPRESSIONS OF THE CITIZENS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 183A of the General Laws, as appearing in the Official
- 2 Acts of 1998, is hereby amended by inserting after section 11 the
- 3 following new section:—
- 4 Section 11A. Any condominium unit owner or resident of a unit
- 5 may display one portable, removable flag of the United States of
- 6 reasonable size and shape in the immediate vicinity of his or her
- 7 unit notwithstanding any condominium by-law, agreement,
- 8 covenant or restriction to the contrary.
