By Mrs. Parente of Milford, petition of Marie J. Parente that the Registrar of Motor Vehicles be authorized to revoke the licenses of certain persons convicted of the crime of rape. Public Safety.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REVOCATION OF LICENSES OF PERSONS CONVICTED OF RAPE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 22 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 section 58 of chapter 64 of the Acts 1998, is hereby further
3 amended by adding the following paragraph:—

4 The registrar shall revoke the license to operate of any person
5 convicted of a violation of section 22, 22A, 23, 24 or 24B of
6 chapter 265 and shall not issue a new license to such person for a
7 period of four years after release from prison. If said person is not
8 sentenced to prison, no new license shall be issued for a period of
9 four years from the date of a finding of guilty.
