AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended in the
3 definition of "Regular compensation" by striking out the third
4 sentence.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law or
2 rule or regulation to the contrary, the retirement allowance granted
3 pursuant to the provisions of sections 1 to 28, inclusive, of said
4 chapter 32 to any member of said teachers' retirement system for
5 whom regular deductions have been withheld pursuant to the pro-
6 visions of section 22 of said chapter 32 on account of compensa-
7 tion received under the terms of an annual contract for additional
8 services in a public day school or compensation for services ren-
9 dered by said member in connection with a school lunch program
10 or for services in connection with a program of instruction of
11 physical education and athletic contests as authorized by section
12 47 of chapter 71 shall include an amount that is based on such
13 member's final three years of such service for which such addi-
14 tional compensation was received.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of section 1 shall apply only to
2 persons who enter or re-enter service as a member of the teachers'

3 retirement system, established under the provisions of said chapter
4 32, on or after to the effective date of this act.
