AN ACT RELATIVE TO CLOTHING IN MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (k) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking the words, “up to one hundred and seventy-five dollars of
4 the sales price on any article of clothing” in lines 166 and 167.
