AN ACT RELATIVE TO UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE RATES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 14 of  
2 chapter 151A of the General Laws, the experience rate of an  
3 employer qualifying under subsection (b) of said section 14 of  
4 said chapter 151A, as most recently amended by section 327 of  
5 chapter 159 of the Acts of 2000, shall be the rate which appears in  
6 the column designated "A" for calendar year 2002.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2002.
