AN ACT RELATIVE TO ABUSE VIOLATIONS BY ALIENS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 209A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998 Offi-
2 cial Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 5A the
3 following section:—

4 Section 5B. Upon the conviction of an alien of a violation of this
5 chapter, the clerk of the court shall, forthwith, notify the United
6 States Naturalization Service of such conviction. If such alien is
7 deported, any restraining order issued may be subsequently extended
8 upon notification to the United States Naturalization Service in
9 behalf of the alien that a judicial review will be held to consider the
10 continued justification for the restraining order.
