RESOLVE RELATIVE TO A STUDY OF CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION AND FIRST AID TRAINING FOR SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS.

1 *Resolved*, That, Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary, a commission shall be established , to investigate the
3 feasibility of requiring all duly licensed school bus operators in
4 the Commonwealth, to participate in Cardiopulmonary Resuscita-
5 tion and/or First Aid training as a condition of their employment
6 as said school bus operator. Said commission shall consist of: one
7 member representing school bus operators, and that member shall
8 be appointed by the AFL-CIO; the director of the Massachusetts
9 Chapter of the American Red Cross, or his designee; one member
10 of the Massachusetts Teachers Association; the director of the
11 Massachusetts Municipal Association, or his designee; one
12 member of the Massachusetts House of Representatives,
13 appointed by the speaker of the House; and one member of the
14 Massachusetts Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate.
15 Said commission shall report their findings to the House and
16 Senate committees on Ways and Means no later than
17 December 10, 2001.
