AN ACT REGARDING ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILD CARE SUBSIDIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 28A of the 1998 Official Edition of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by inserting at the end of section 4,
3 subsection (m), the following:—
4 (n) Parents or legal guardians who meet state approved income
5 guidelines and other criteria established by the office shall be eli-
6 gible to receive child care subsidies administered by the office to
7 subsidize the costs of care for children from birth through age 15,
8 or the successful completion of the eighth grade, whichever comes
9 first.
