AN ACT RELATIVE TO STREET BETTERMENT ASSESSMENTS IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirteen of chapter
2 eighty of the General Laws, or of any general or special law to the
3 contrary, the city of Worcester is hereby authorized upon the
4 application of any owner of real property abutting a way to appor-
5 tion street betterment assessments for a period of up to ten years
6 such that interest only payments shall be required until the final
7 year when the total assessment, including that year's interest, shall
8 become due and payable. This authority is supplemental and in
9 addition to the authority to apportion betterment assessments as
10 provided in section thirteen of chapter eighty. The provisions of
11 section thirteen of chapter eighty regarding the applicable rate of
12 interest shall apply to all betterments apportioned under authority
13 of this act.
