4 numbered 2207 and 3385, relative to Genetically Modified Crops.

6 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
8 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
9 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday of
10 December, two thousand one.
