AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN PERSONS AS FIRE-FIGHTERS IN THE TOWN OF IPSWICH NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or  
2 rule to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants for  
3 appointment as a firefighter, the personnel administrator shall cer-  
4 tify the names of Robert Bowen, Dennis Howes, Keith LeBlanc  
5 and Roland Martineau for original appointment to the position of  
6 firefighter in the town of Ipswich according to the score of each  
7 on the civil service examination for such position and provided  
8 that Robert Bowen, Dennis Howes, Keith LeBlanc and Roland  
9 Martineau meet all of the requirements for such appointment to  
10 such position, the town of Ipswich may appoint them.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
