

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE REPRESENTATION OF THE CITY OF LOWELL  
IN THE TRUSTEES OF THE LOWELL TEXTILE SCHOOL CORPORATION. *Chap.349*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. During any school year, which for the purposes of this act shall be construed as a period of twelve calendar months beginning with the first day of July in each year, the chairman of the board of aldermen, the president of the common council, and a member of the textile union of the city of Lowell, who shall be appointed by the Lowell Textile Council, shall be members of the board of trustees of the Lowell Textile School Corporation.

Trustees of Lowell Textile School Corporation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMMITMENT OF INSANE PERSONS TO  
INSANE ASYLUMS. *Chap.350*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. A person applying for the commitment or for the admission of an insane person to a state insane hospital under the provisions of chapter eighty-seven of the Public Statutes, or for commitment of a dipsomaniac under the provisions of chapter three hundred and thirty-nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five, or under the provisions of chapter four hundred and fourteen of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, shall first give notice in writing to the overseers of the poor of the place where the insane person or dipsomaniac resides, except that in the city of Boston such notice shall be given to the institutions registrar, and also to the chairman of the insane hospital trustees, of his intention to make such application; and satisfactory evidence that such notice has been given shall be produced to the justice in cases of commitment. But this act shall not apply to cases provided for in section one of chapter four hundred and thirty-eight of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.

Commitments, etc., to insane hospitals and to hospital for dipsomaniacs, etc.

Not to apply to certain cases.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
