AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BRAINTREE TO ESTABLISH A SEPARATE ACCOUNT FOR COMMUNITY PRESERVATION AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 7 OF CHAPTER 44B.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 10 of chapter 64D,
- 2 the Register of Deeds shall, not later than the tenth day of each
- 3 subsequent month, transmit to the treasurer of the town of Brain-
- 4 tree the taxes collected during any month under said chapter with
- 5 respect to properties located in said town. The expenditure of said
- 6 revenues shall be subject to the provisions of chapter 44B.
