AN ACT TO CLARIFY CONTINUOUS SERVICE IN A RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 22 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 2002 Official Edition, is amended in subsection (1) (b) by
3 adding the following subsection:— (vii) For the purposes of this
4 subsection any member in service who was laid off because of
5 reduction in force caused by budget cuts, whether or not such
6 member withdrew contributions to the retirement system, upon
7 reinstatement and repayment of such contributions shall be con-
8 sidered to have maintained continuous active service in the retire-
9 ment system and such member's rate of contribution shall be the
10 same as the initial date of employment.
