AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTORCYCLE INSURANCE PREMIUM CHARGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 113B of Chapter 175 of the Massachusetts General
2 Laws 2002 Official Edition shall be amended by inserting after
3 line 112 the following paragraph:—

4 In fixing and establishing classifications of risks, the commis-
5 sioner shall annually assess and collect upon Company license
6 renewal, from each insurer writing motorcycle liability policies,
7 five percent (5%) of the prior year's earned premiums on such
8 motorcycle policies, and the Commission or person collecting
9 such assessment shall pay those collected into the General Fund
10 and such fees shall be appropriated solely for the purpose of pro-
11 moting and advancing motorcycle safety and reducing accidents
12 and claims, in accordance with Massachusetts General Law
13 Chapter 90, Section 34.
