

Chap. 52 AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE EXPERIMENT STATION
AT THE MASSACHUSETTS AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Appropriations. SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the purposes specified, for the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and one, to wit: —

Agricultural experiment station. For maintaining an agricultural experiment station at the Massachusetts Agricultural College, the sum of ten thousand dollars.

Collecting, etc., samples of concentrated commercial feed stuffs. For defraying the expense of collecting and analyzing samples of concentrated commercial feed stuffs, as provided for by chapter one hundred and seventeen of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, the sum of twelve hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 53 AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE MASSACHUSETTS AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Appropriations. SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the purposes specified, for the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and one, to wit: —

Agricultural college, scholarships. For the Massachusetts Agricultural College, for the purpose of providing eighty free scholarships, the sum of ten thousand dollars.

Labor fund, etc. For the Massachusetts Agricultural College, the sum of ten thousand dollars, to be expended under the direction of the trustees for the following purposes, to wit: — Five thousand dollars for the establishment of a labor fund to assist needy students of said college, and five thousand dollars to provide the theoretical and practical education required by its charter and by the laws of the United States relating thereto.

Instruction. For the Massachusetts Agricultural College, for the purpose of providing the instruction called for by its charter and by the law of the United States relating to the college, the sum of eight thousand dollars.

For travelling and other necessary expenses of the trustees of the Massachusetts Agricultural College, a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars. Expenses of trustees.

For a maintenance fund for the veterinary laboratory at the Massachusetts Agricultural College, the sum of one thousand dollars. Veterinary laboratory.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF RAILROAD COMMISSIONERS. *Chap. 54*
Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The board of railroad commissioners is hereby authorized to expend a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars annually in procuring necessary books, maps, statistics and stationery, and in defraying expenses incidental and necessary to the discharge of its duties. A statement of such expenditures shall accompany its annual report. Railroad commissioners, expenses.

SECTION 2. So much of section ten of chapter one hundred and twelve of the Public Statutes as is inconsistent with this act, and chapter two hundred of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety, are hereby repealed. Repeal.

SECTION 3. The provisions of section twelve of chapter one hundred and twelve of the Public Statutes shall apply to the expenses authorized by this act. P. S. 112, § 12, to apply.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF READING TO MAKE AN ADDITIONAL WATER LOAN. *Chap. 55*

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Reading, for the purposes mentioned in section six of chapter four hundred and five of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, and subject to the provisions of said act, may issue bonds, notes or scrip, to be denominated on the face thereof, Reading Water Loan, to an amount not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars in addition to the amounts heretofore authorized by law to be issued by said town for the same purposes. Reading Water Loan.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
