AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WALTHAM TO CONSTRUCT A VETERANS MEMORIAL AND COMMUNITY BANDSTAND ON WALTHAM COMMON AND TO INSTALL PLAQUES HONORING VETERANS AND NOTABLE INDIVIDUALS AND EVENTS IN WALTHAM'S HISTORY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Waltham is hereby authorized to use,
2 construct and reconstruct a veterans memorial and community
3 bandstand on a certain parcel of open space in said city. Said
4 parcel (Waltham Common) is shown as Map 60, Block 20, Lot 01
5 of the map of the city of Waltham which is on file in the office of
6 the city engineer.

1 SECTION 2. Said city is hereby further authorized to install on
2 said parcel plaques honoring veterans and notable individuals and
3 events in said city's history.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
