AN ACT TO CONVEY CERTAIN COMMONWEALTH PROPERTY CONSISTING OF THE WATERS OF FARM POND, ITS TRIBUTARIES, AND WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM TO THE TOWN OF SHERBORN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the com-
2 missioner of the Department of Mental Health, with the assistance
3 of the Commissioner of the Department of Capital Assets Man-
4 agement and Maintenance, shall grant, convey and deed over,
5 without consideration, to the town of Sherborn all rights, title or
6 other real property interests that the Commonwealth may hold as a
7 result of chapter 251 of the Acts of 1897 and chapter 466 of the
8 Acts of 1908, to the waters of Farm Pond in the town of Sherborn,
9 the tributaries of such Farm Pond, and to a certain easements
10 together with a pipeline from said Pond running underground
11 within the Town of Sherborn, to the boundary between the town
12 of Sherborn and the town of Medfield, heretofore used to convey
13 such waters to the now closed Medfield State Hospital, for the
14 Town of Sherborn to have and to hold, for public recreation, water
15 supply and fire protection purposes.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
