

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PERKINS INSTITUTION AND MASSACHUSETTS SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND. *Chap. 247*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The sum of thirty thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, to the Perkins Institution and Massachusetts School for the Blind, as provided for by chapter nineteen of the resolves of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-nine. Perkins Institution and Massachusetts School for the Blind.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SALARIES AND EXPENSES OF THE INSPECTORS OF GAS METERS. *Chap. 248*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the purposes specified, for the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and one, to wit:— Appropriations.

For the salary of the inspector of gas meters, twenty-five hundred dollars. Inspector of gas meters.

For the salary of the first assistant inspector of gas meters, fifteen hundred dollars. First assistant.

For the salary of the second assistant inspector of gas meters, twelve hundred dollars. Second assistant.

For the compensation of deputies of the inspector of gas meters, a sum not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars. Deputies.

For travelling and incidental expenses of the inspectors of gas meters, a sum not exceeding twelve hundred dollars. Expenses.

For rent, apparatus, and general office expenses of the inspector of gas meters, a sum not exceeding sixteen hundred dollars. Rent, apparatus, etc.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
