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AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN TOWN OFFICIALS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1B of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 word “majority”, in lines 3 and 12, and inserting in place thereof,  
4 in each instance, the following:— two-thirds.
