AN ACT AUTHORIZING THOMAS TAYLOR TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ELIGIBILITY AS A FIREFIGHTER IN THE TOWN OF WILMINGTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule
2 or regulation to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an
3 applicant for appointment as firefighter, Thomas Taylor shall be
4 allowed to have his civil service exam test results from April, 2004
5 considered by the town of Wilmington for his appointment to the
6 position of firefighter in the town of Wilmington, and if he meets all
7 other requirements, he shall be eligible for certification and appoint-
8 ment to the fire department of the town of Wilmington.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
