AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GARDNER TO GRANT AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 17 of
2 chapter 138 of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the
3 City of Gardner may grant to the Moon Hill Brewing Company,
4 Inc. d/b/a Gardner Ale House a license to sell all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises at 74 Parker Street in said city
5 under the provisions of section 12 of said chapter 138. Said
6 license shall be subject to all of said chapter 138, except section
7 17; provided, however, that the licensing authority shall not
8 approve the transfer of the license to any other person, organization,
9 corporation or location.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
