4 ment numbered 2485 and current House document numbered 4745
5 relative to land use regulations and land in the town of Weymouth.
6 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of
7 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
8 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
9 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
10 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
11 December, 2006.
