AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSITIONAL ESCROW FUND.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to transfer forthwith certain funds
3 from the transitional escrow fund, therefore it is hereby declared
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
5 of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, not
2 less than 10 days after the transfer authorized in section 132, the
3 comptroller shall transfer the balance of Transitional Escrow
4 Fund, established by section 16 of chapter 106 of the acts of 2005,
5 to the General Fund.
