AN ACT REGARDING THE ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule or regulation,
2 to the contrary the Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission is
3 hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
4 on the adequacy and efficiency of the law, presently appearing in
5 chapter 138 of the General Laws and any regulations thereto, gov-
6 erning the general supervision of the conduct of the business of man-
7 ufacturing, importing, exporting, storing, transporting and selling
8 alcoholic beverages and the quality, purity and alcoholic contents
9 thereof, and to make such legislative recommendations to modernize
10 and update make such law and regulations as said Alcoholic Bev-
11 erage Control Commission necessary. The commission shall file a
12 report on the results of its study, together with its recommendations,
13 if any, and drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommenda-
14 tions into effect, with the clerks of the house of representatives and
15 the senate not later than December 12, 2007.
