**Chap.481** AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SALARIES AND EXPENSES AT THE LYMAN SCHOOL FOR BOYS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Appropriations.

SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the purposes specified, for the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and one, to wit: —

Lyman school for boys, salaries, wages, etc.

For salaries, wages and labor at the Lyman school for boys, a sum not exceeding twenty-nine thousand six hundred dollars.

Expenses.

For other current expenses at the Lyman school for boys, a sum not exceeding forty-five thousand four hundred and ten dollars.

Agents.

For salaries and expenses of such agents as the trustees of the Lyman and industrial schools may deem necessary, a sum not exceeding seven thousand five hundred dollars.

Boarding out children.

For expenses in connection with boarding out children by the trustees of the Lyman and industrial schools, a sum not exceeding five thousand five hundred dollars.

Instruction in public schools.

For instruction in the public schools in any city or town in the Commonwealth of children boarded or bound out by the trustees of the Lyman and industrial schools, a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap.482** AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ELECTION OF TOWN CLERKS AND TO THEIR DUTIES.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Election, etc, of town clerks in certain towns.

SECTION 1. Any town which at a meeting duly called for the purpose accepts the provisions of this act may choose by ballot at its regular annual meeting its town clerk for the term of three years, who shall hold his office for said term and until another person is chosen and qualified in his stead. The clerk so chosen may be clerk of such officers, boards and departments of the town as the town may determine by vote at the meeting
