AN ACT STREAMLINING THE REGIONAL SCHOOL BUDGET PROCESS.

1 Whereas, The deferred operation of this act operation of this act  
2 would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to streamline and expedite  
3 the regional school budget process, therefore it is hereby declared to  
4 be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of  
5 the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 21C of Chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended in paragraph (i½), line 124 by adding at the end of “capital  
3 outlay expenditures” the following:—or for the city’s or town’s  
4 apportioned share for certain capital outlay expenditures by a  
5 regional governmental unit.

6 And by striking “nineteen hundred” and replacing with the text  
7 “two thousand” in line 132 of said paragraph.
