AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE HAVEY BEACH RESERVATION IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the  
2 Havey Beach Reservation areas, so-called, of the Charles River, in  
3 the West Roxbury section of the city of Boston shall be the Havey  
4 Beach Reservation Great Pond pursuant to Section 35 of chapter 91  
5 of the General Laws and the department of conservation and recre-  
6 ation shall bear all appropriate costs necessary for improvements to  
7 the Havey Beach Reservation including but not limited to survey,  
8 building improvements, and landscaping plan, which shall include,  
9 but shall not be limited solely to construction of boat docks and  
10 launches, running, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and an area for dog  
11 run on said Reservation. The department shall enter into a lease of  
12 not less than 5 years with an option to renew for 5 years for seasonal  
13 use with a water related entity pursuant to said Chapter 91 to pro-  
14 mote the use of the Great Pond.
