AN ACT RELATIVE TO CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 13J of Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 2000 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines  
3 18 and 19, the words “for not more than five years, or by imprison-  
4 ment in a jail or house of correction for not more than two and one-  
5 half years” and inserting in place thereof the following words:— for  
6 life or for any term of years.
