### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING WORKERS COMPENSATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The third paragraph of subsection (5) of section 1 of chapter 152  
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition, is  
3 hereby amended by striking out the third sentence and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following sentence:— The word “employer”  
5 should not include nonprofit entities, as defined by the Internal Rev-  
6 enue Code, that are staffed by volunteers, board members, directors,  
7 and paid employees.
