AN ACT TO ALLOW A FORMER NATIONAL GUARDSMAN CREDITABLE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 4 of Chapter 32 of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, the Massa-  
3 chusetts Retirement board is hereby authorized and directed to grant  
4 Dennis Otis creditable service for the years of 1964 to 1970, inclu-  
5 sive, during which he served within the Massachusetts National  
6 Guard; provided, however, that he shall pay into the annuity savings  
7 fund, in one sum or installments, as the board shall determine, an  
8 amount equal to the regular deductions which would have been  
9 deducted for said period together with regular deductions which  
10 would have been deducted for said period together with regular  
11 interest thereon. Dennis Otis shall, in addition to his actual member-  
12 ship service, be entitled to credit for the portion of the creditable  
13 service which the total of his actual payments, together with regular  
14 interest thereon to the date such retirement becomes effective, bears  
15 to the total amount of what her payment, together with regular  
16 interest thereon, would have been had he made a payment in one  
17 sum on the effective date of his retirement.
