AN ACT RELATIVE TO VETERANS BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out, in lines 767 to 770, inclusive, the words “to the amount
4 of six thousand dollars of the taxable valuation of real property or
5 the sum of \$600, whichever would result in an abatement of the
6 greater amount of taxes due,” and inserting in place thereof the
7 following words: — to the full amount of the taxable valuation of
8 real property.

1 SECTION 2. Said Section 5 of said Chapter 59 is further
2 amended by striking out, in lines 788 and 789, the words “up to four
3 thousand dollars of exemption or up to the sum of \$425, whichever
4 basis is applicable,”
