AN ACT ENHANCING THE CULTURAL FACILITIES FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection 42(b)(1) of Chapter 23G of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the words "Municipally  
3 owned buildings, structures or sites must be a minimum of 50,000  
4 square feet in size, of which at least 50 per cent is used as a cultural  
5 facility" the following language:—  
6 "unless said municipally owned building is one hundred and fifty  
7 years old or more and significant in the history, archeology, architec-  
8 ture or culture of the nation, the Commonwealth or said community,  
9 in which case it may be of any size."

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
